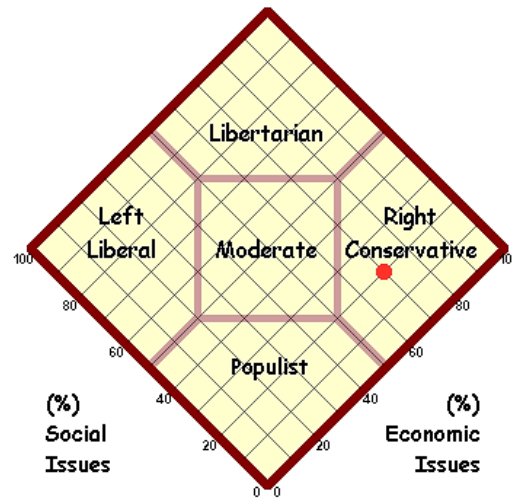

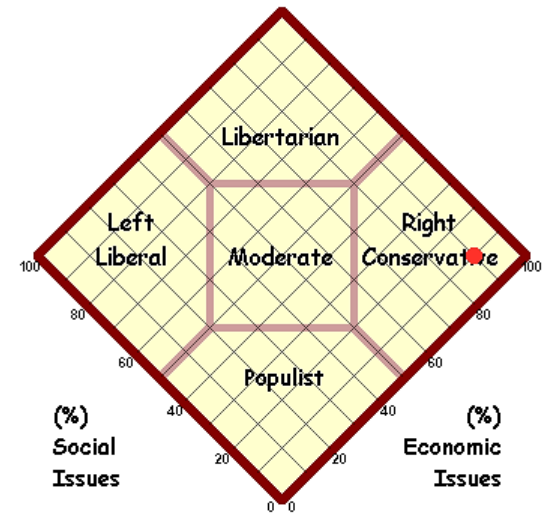
Bernie Sanders is a Hard-Core Liberal.

Jeb Bush is a Populist-Leaning Conservative.

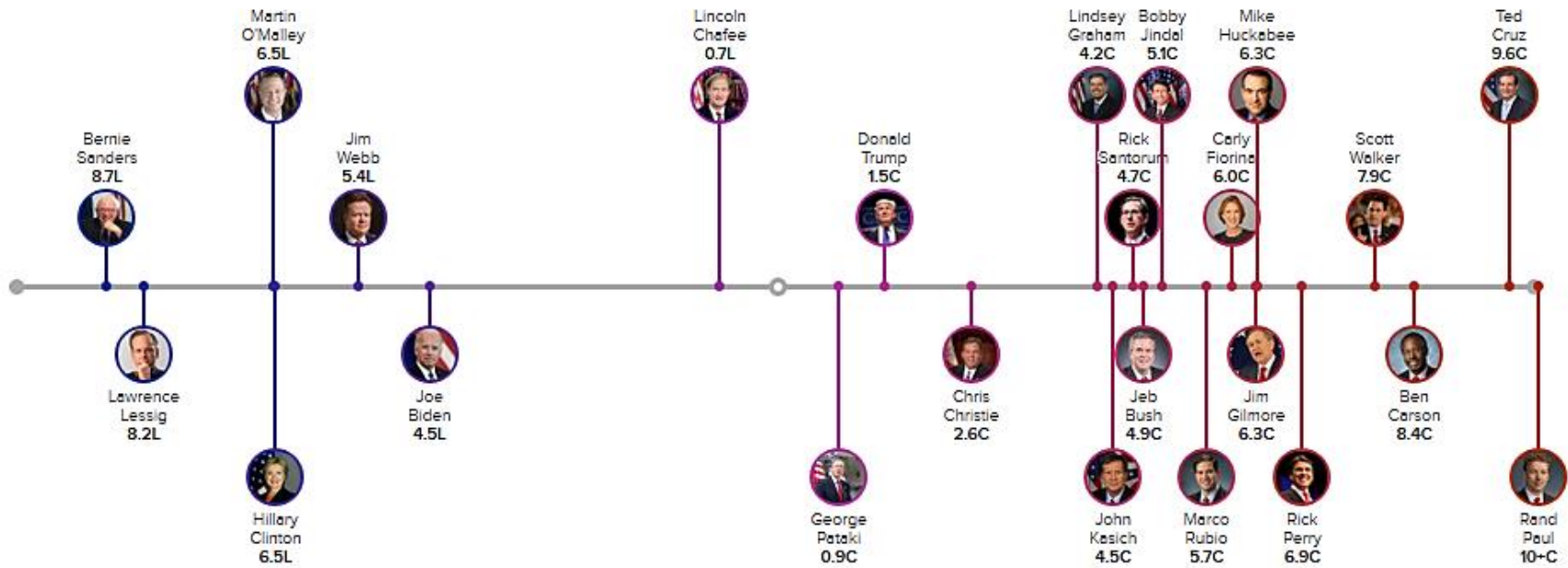


Ted Cruz is a Hard-Core Conservative.

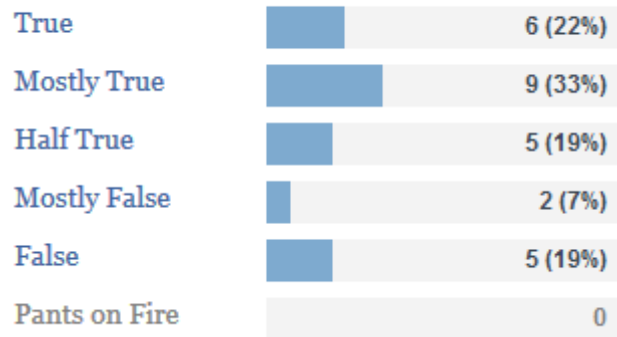


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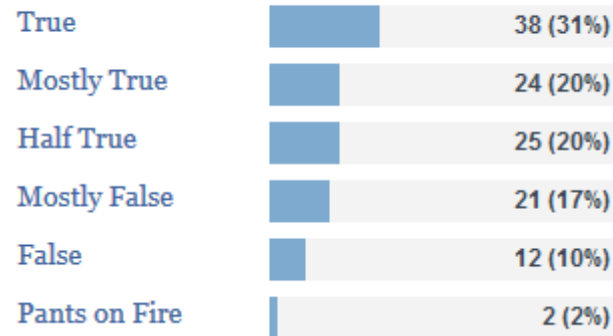

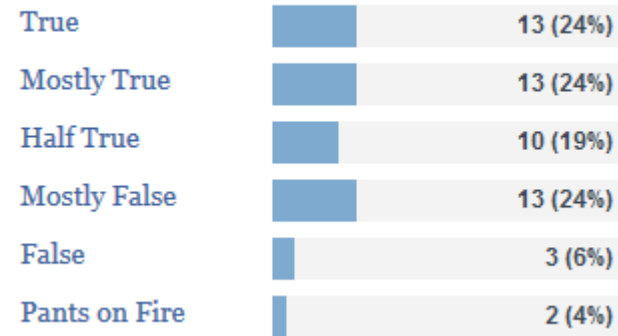
Sanders's statements by ruling



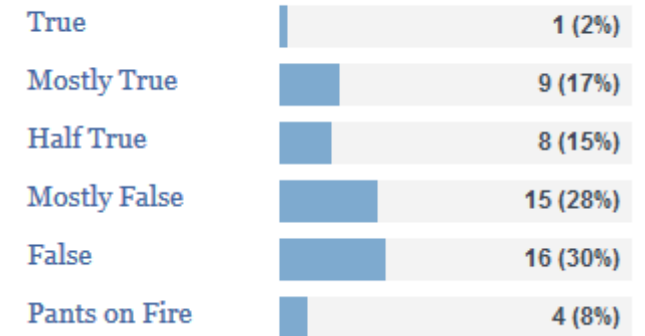
Clinton's statements by ruling
